Facilities Cleaning, Sanitizing, Disinfecting and Ventilation

Requirement(s)	Strategies, Policies and Procedures
* Cleaning, sanitizing, disinfecting, and ventilating learning spaces, surfaces, and any other areas used by students (i.e., restrooms, drinking fountains, hallways, and transportation)	Areas will be cleaned and disinfected (at least) daily. Regular cleaning/sanitizing of restrooms will occur throughout the day Newly installed HVAC system provides adequate ventilation throughout the district Water fountains may be converted to hands-free water bottle filling stations.

Social Distancing and Other Safety Protocols

Requirement(s)	Strategies, Policies and Procedures
* Classroom/learning space occupancy that allows for 6 feet of separation among students and staff throughout the day, to the maximum extent feasible	- All classrooms will distance student desks as much as possible within the classroom. All desks/tables will be arranged to face the same direction to avoid students facing each other in the classroom.
* Restricting the use of cafeterias and other congregate settings, and serving meals in alternate settings such as classrooms	- Some students will eat breakfast and lunch in their classrooms to allow for social distancing for students who will eat in the classroom.
* Hygiene practices for students and staff including the manner and frequency of hand-washing and other best practices	- Hand Sanitizer will be available and use of same encouraged in each classroom, office, and common area throughout the district. Handwashing/sanitizer before

<p>* Monitoring students and staff for symptoms and history of exposure</p> <p>* Isolating or quarantining students, staff, or visitors if they become sick or demonstrate a history of exposure</p>	<p>Teachers and staff will monitor individuals displaying any type of illness or symptoms, and notify nurse immediately.</p> <p>- Students/Staff exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19 will meet immediately with FASD Health staff for an individual assessment. They will be isolated within the health suite, if</p>

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<p>* Returning isolated or quarantined staff, students, or visitors to school</p>	<p>possible/practicable. Those individuals will be separated from building population until deemed ready for re-entry into school.</p>
<p>Notifying staff, families, and the public of school closures and within-school- year changes in safety protocols</p>	<p>Individuals must have an excuse from a health care professional, or okay from the State Department of Health to return.</p>

<p>* Protecting students and staff at higher risk for severe illness</p>	<p>Students and staff will follow CDC and State Department of Health requirements, and may be required to wear masks.</p>
<p>* Use of face coverings (masks or face shields) by all staff</p>	<p>Staff may be required to wear face masks or shields, unless medically unable to do so.</p>
<p>* Use of face coverings (masks or face shields) by older students (as appropriate)</p>	<p>All students (who are able to) will be encouraged to wear face masks.</p>
